Launch & tractor fees for boats and jet-ski's

- After hours tractor services – R50 - covers launch and retrieval
- **DSBC & DUC members** – if your boat is registered at another club and therefore **does not have a S or DUC number** you need to register the boats number with dave@pwsc.co.za at least 1 day before you launch in order to get free launch services. If your boat is not on the list of approved members boats without S/DUC numbers, available in the launch control hut, you will be asked to pay for your launch services even if you are a member. You can request at the office for a refund when you register your boat number before the next trip. Please renew these arrangements each year at the office.
- **#DTD / Commercial boats** may apply to Committee@DSBC.co.za for an exemption from the launch fee which will be confirmed in writing. If you wish to make use of tractor services you may elect to pay an annual levy of R5,000 in lieu of cost per tow. If your boat is not on the list of DTD exemptions available in the control hut you are required to pay for launch services. These arrangements are valid for one year and application needs to be made each year for review.

- DSBC and DUC members whose accounts are in arrears are not entitled to free launch services until their accounts have been brought up to date. You will be required to pay cash fees applicable to “all other boats”.

Payment conditions for launch and tractor fees

- After hours tractor fee – R50 cash paid to driver when launching
- All services are to be paid in full before launching.
- Only cash payments are acceptable – no card machines are available at the launch control hut.
- Gate security staff is not permitted to make any exceptions to these fees.
- Should you be short of cash to make full payment, the club management and committees will permit you to launch on the day and pay on your return provided that full payment is received before you leave the club premises.

Wash bay rules

There is no charge for self-washing your boat in the wash-bay after you return, however we ask that you adhere to the following rules;

- 30 minute maximum time limit so that others have an opportunity to wash as well.
- Boat is not to be left unattended at any time. Any unattended boats may be removed by the tractor drivers and will need to go to the end of the queue

A paid boat-wash service is available on weekends and public holidays subject to weather conditions;

- Pay the wash-bay crew cash according to their price list.
- At least one boat crew with keys to the tow vehicle shall remain at the wash-bay at all times and remove the boat from the wash-bay as soon as the boat is ready.
